CODE OF CONDUCT OF THE COLLEGE

- The students admitted to the college must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the college
 authorities.
- Violation of rules, indiscipline and misconduct of any kind may lead to disciplinary action like compulsory transfer/ expulsion from the college / hostel.
- Students must attend classes in prescribed uniform.
- A student should attend a minimum of 80% classes (as per latest DU regulation) held during an academic year. Students whose attendance fall below 80% but above 70% will be considered as non-collegiate. Students with attendance below 70% may be debarred from appearing in the final examination. Non-collegiate students will have to pay heavy fines at the time of filling up of examination form and there will be parent contact with the Principal. Parent will be called by the Principal.
- Appearing in the college examinations (Sessional/ terminals/ class tests/ unit tests) is compulsory, failing which they will not be allowed to fill up examination forms.
- Seminar/ Group Discussion/ Assignment/ Field works are compulsory and must be completed in time.
- Students should frequently visit the college notice boards for any notification from the Principal, University
 or any other authority. Immediate response to such notification is very important.
- Students should be very much particular in filling up/ submitting/ signing various important documents related to their study/ examination etc.
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College. If any incident of Ragging comes to the notice of the
 authority, the same shall be dealt with as per rules.
- Use of mobile phone in the College campus during class time (without permission) is considered as offence
 and one is liable to face punitive action for violation of college rules on this matter.
